E-Vetting Procedure

The above link explains the e-vetting process for the GAA. It has all the information you will need about being vetted. It outlines the steps involved and there is also a link to complete the e-vetting application form online.

Follow the 3 steps below to complete your vetting:

1: E-vetting I.D. Form

Complete the form below and attach a copy of photo I.D. (passport or driver's licence) and proof of address (utility bill) and send it me, the Children's Officer, Aoife Britton. It will then be signed by me and retained until the vetting is complete.

2: GAA vetting application form

You must then complete the online GAA vetting application form. All the information is then forwarded to the National Vetting Bureau by the GAA.

3: National Vetting Bureau application form

You will then be issued with a NVB application form. This will be issued to your own personal email address you provided. All information provided in this section is in confidence between you and the NVB.

Notes:

- Vetting in the GAA is for a period of 3 years.
- Anyone under 18 must have the parental consent section filled out by a parent or guardian.
