2012 We bought the additional 10 acres next to our current pitch and facilities.

2016 Camogie started in the club.

2017 History was created in the club when John Hanbury became the first member of the club to win an All Ireland senior hurling medal with Galway.

> From 2017 to 2021, our club doubled the number of members to almost 800. Club fielded our first senior camogie group.

2021 We upgraded our car park and wall ball at a cost of 140k.


